B. School Operations

- a. TCAP scores are still embargoed by the state. We are waiting for them to release scores for the school. We did show a significant amount of growth in most areas.
- b. The School Improvement Plan for this school year is due by the end of the month. We are working diligently on getting this complete.
- c. We are still in the process of hiring teachers for the new school year. We have hired the needed TA's, a new administrative secretary, and aftercare staff. We are still in need of a music teacher.
- d. We are in the process of applying for a line of credit with First Horizon Bank to help cover the operating expenses which includes payroll for the school.
- e. Miles and a few college students over the summer have worked hard on creating a marketing plan for the school. We are waiting for them to finalize this plan so that we can recruit more students to our school.
- f. I have been in contact with Code Crew to implement the STEM program at our school for one of our support classes, however the cost is very expensive to offer for a support class. The afterschool price would be more feasible, but all students would not be exposed to the program. I did send information about our school because there is some potential for grant funding on their end.
- g. I would like to thank each of you for coming out to support the Arrows on their first day of school. Also, the Corvette Club represented with backpacks and school supplies for each grade level and students were excited to take pictures with the cars.

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h. A big thank you goes out to Ms. Lynnette Morrison for donating 120 backpacks and school supplies.

i. Today Benchmark Reality – Mr. Dickerson and Ms. Allen donated 100 water bottles to the students and staff.

C. Facilities Update

a. Gipson Mechanical is in the process of completing our boiler and hot water tank. This

work began on July 5th and is still in progress.
