- b. Moolah Wireless is a tech company that solves the problems of mobile accessibility and wireless connectivity for under-represented/under-resourced communities by leveraging federal assistance programs to eliminate the cost of devices for at-need individuals. Each student will receive a free tablet with the parent's consent to use it at home. Due to the weather, there has been a pushback on the delivery of these items. - c. Our MAP testing is almost complete. We will finish our winter MAP testing, drill-downs, and make-up testing this week. After completion, we will analyze this data to form our small group instruction for our TCAP Blitz.
